



**PUBLIC HEARING ICDBG**  
 Wyandotte City Hall  
 13 October 2021

The Quapaw Nation is now preparing to apply to the U.S. Department of Housing (HUD) Indian Community Development Block Grant Program (ICDBG) for the construction of a new Fire and EMS Station in the Town of Wyandotte, OK on Hwy 60.

This is a single purpose grant that is highly competitive. Eighty grants will be made by HUD across the entire United States. The application will be seeking \$1M dollars for the new station under the application’s “Public Facilities and Infrastructure Project category. The Funding Opportunity Number is: FR-6500-N-23.

We are here not only to discuss the possibility of funding a new Fire and EMS station, but to consider other types of projects eligible under the ICDBG, which the public would like to express an interest in. These include new housing construction; housing rehabilitation, housing acquisition, land acquisition to support new housing and homeownership assistance and microenterprise programs.

BACKGROUND ON THE NOTICE OF FUNDING OPPORTUNITY (NOFO)

- Application must be submitted by 25 October 2021;
- It is a single fiscal year funding source for 2021;
- Total funding is \$76.5M for the country. Available funds for our region \$21.5M;
- Maximum award from the \$21.5M is \$1M per tribe; and
- Grant period can be up to five years.
