Notice is hereby given that the Quapaw Nation will hold a Citizen Participation Meeting on October 13, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. at the Town of Wyandotte City Hall, 212 S Main Street, OK 74370. The Meeting will be to discuss the Nation's application for Fiscal Year 2021 Indian Community Development Block Grant (ICDBG) funding.

The Quapaw Nation is always encouraged and often required by US Federal agencies to hold citizen participation meetings for many of its grant programs. We will be meeting to present our proposal for the construction of a new Fire and EMS station to be built in Wyandotte. We will discuss and review the requirements of the application and gather input and comments regarding the proposed structure that will be submitted by the Quapaw Nation or or before the deadline of October 25<sup>th</sup>.

### **FY 2021 Indian Community Development Block Grant (ICDBG)**

Projects funded by the Indian Community Development Block Grant Program must meet the Objective defined in 24 CFR 1003.2, to principally benefit low-and-moderate income persons.

Notification of the *Indian Community Development Block Grant* funding for FY2021 has been published. Grant ceiling is in the amount of \$1,000,000.

This will be a single purpose application for the ICDBG eligible activity for *Public Facilities and Improvements*.
