



## INCLEMENT WEATHER PROCEDURES FOR QUAPAW TRIBAL ENTITIES

### QUAPAW TRIBAL OFFICES

If Quapaw Public Schools are out for inclement weather than the Quapaw Tribal offices are closed the first day, too. The Tribal Administrator will evaluate the conditions each day, after the first day with the Fire/EMS and the Law Marshals. A decision will then be made accordingly, and the employees will be notified.

### QUAPAW COUNSELING SERVICES

If the decision is made that the weather will interfere with driving, they have patients that they contact to have them come in early. The doctor then must be called to okay a snow day, then they call Donna, and then contact SAMHSA. They try and plan for bad weather by putting employees up at a nearby hotel, so that they can make it to work. They work with a skeleton crew that consists of one nurse for dosing, and one front office staff.

### QUAPAW SERVICES AUTHORITY

The maintenance guys come in early and clear off the parking lots and sidewalks. The QSA crew goes and pushes snow at Downstream. Johnnie Rodgers will make the determination regarding the construction crews, depending on the road conditions. Mitch Albright will make the decision regarding employees at the Quapaw Cattle Company, and the Quapaw Food Services Authority. Donna Mercer will make the decision regarding the QSA office staff.

### QUAPAW TRIBAL GAMING AGENCY

They do not close for any weather-related issues, however they let the employees make the decision on whether they can make it in to work or not. They have people that live near work and normally only have a few people that call in, each time there is inclement weather.

**Our Fire/EMS and Law Marshals are not affected by the inclement weather procedures, due to the nature of their work.**
